



ROMPSTERS SUGGESTED SUPPLIES FOR CANINE FIRST AID TRAVEL KIT

- gauze, sterile pads and self-clinging elastic wraps
- blunt nose scissors for cutting gauze and hair on your animal
- Bach Rescue Remedy for Pets - liquid and cream
- tweezers
- alcohol for cleaning scissors, tweezers & nail cutters before using or Pawtizer (alcohol free)
- Ticked Off, Tick Ease or Tick Key
- nail cutters
- styptic powder to halt a cut nail from bleeding
- inflatable or plastic Elizabethan collar can be used to keep the animal from licking any topical medicine
- muzzle for an injured dog that could potentially bite if in pain (do NOT muzzle an animal that is vomiting or having difficulty breathing)
- antiseptic for preventing infection and disinfecting minor wounds
- antiseptic wipes for your hands and a cut on your dog
- triple antibiotic ointment (ask your vet about application to wounds)
- hydrogen peroxide (3% strength) - discuss induced vomiting with your vet
- empty 1 liter soda bottle or 16 oz water bottle for adding warm water and placing against an injured animal to keep them warm
- saline eye wash
- latex gloves
- antihistamine for allergic reactions (ask your vet about dosage)
- hydrocortisone cream for to reduce the amount of itching if animal bitten by an insect
- emergency numbers for poison control or vets on call
